### Vehicles of Interest Sought in an ATM Theft Offense: 1300 Block of Irving Street, Northwest

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department’s Criminal Investigations Division and the FBI Violent Crimes Task Force seek the public’s assistance in identifying and locating vehicles of interest in reference to a ATM Theft offense that occurred on Wednesday, September 22, 2021, in the 1300 block of Irving Street, Northwest

At approximately 4:21 am, the suspects, used a vehicle to forcefully remove an ATM from inside of a structure. The suspects fled the scene in vehicles.

The vehicles of interest were captured by a surveillance camera and can be seen in the photos below:
